Purpose:

NUKE EM® can reduce populations of certain plant pests including Spider Mite, Whitefly, Aphid and Powdery Mildew. NUKE EM® kills larvae, juvenile and adult parasites.

Do not spray on top of or mix with other insecticides.

Mix and apply the same day.

Commercial Growers:

Match batch dates with quality control lab tests located on the Flying Skull website. Use clean spray equipment.

Directions:

- 1. Thoroughly shake the bottle.
- 2. Indoor: Water the growing media until a significant amount of runoff occurs.
- Outdoor: Water media in pots and water field if possible.
- 3. Indoor: May be sprayed under fluorescent or LED lighting. Turn heat producing light down. Resume high intensity light when leaves are dry.
- Outdoor: Apply early or late in the day. Avoid spraying mid-day.

Mixing Rates:

Normal Strength (start here then observe): Add 1 fl. oz. to 1 quart of water or 4 fl. oz. to 1 gallon of water.
